Ottawa Conservation District 2020 Habitat Assessment Technician Position Posting

DESCRIPTION

The Ottawa Conservation District is looking for 2 qualified individuals to assist the Sand Creek Trout Habitat Assessment Project. This project entails the monitoring of stream conditions within the Sand Creek Watershed. These positions will be working with District staff to compile data on existing road stream crossings, and conduct habitat assessments at key locations throughout the watershed. These assessments will focus on conditions such as stream depth, turbidity, substrate, bank stability, and more. The goal of the Sand Creek Trout Habitat Assessment Project is to provide an overview of watershed health as it relates to fisheries, documenting sources of degradation, and planning for future restoration efforts as necessary.

TIME COMMITMENT & COMPENSATION

May-August, 16 hours/week; position pays \$12.00 an hour and can be applied for College/University credits.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with collection of data for road stream crossings throughout Pigeon River and Sand Creek Watersheds
- Photo documentation of trout habitat and surrounding area
- Data entry (Excel), filing, and other general office duties
- Provide GIS mapping support
- Other duties as assigned by the Conservation Technician

REQUIREMENTS

The Ottawa Conservation District is looking for a recent graduate or current graduate/undergraduate student in the West Michigan area who majored in or is currently majoring in Natural Resource Management, Geography, Environmental Science, Biology or a related field. This person should have excellent organizational skills, with knowledge of ArcGIS, Word, and Excel. While working in the field, will be working in inclement weather such as rain and extreme heat/cold while doing physical work such as hiking for extended periods on uneven terrain. Valid driver's license and reliable transportation is required.
